

THE BEE SAFE ORGANIC LAWN MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Standardizing an organic approach to lawn care was not an easy process. To implement a natural approach to caring for turf means that we must inherently manipulate soil biology. This is a very different process than manipulating growth habits of the turf via chemicals. Some lawns are irrigated and some are not. Some are watered twice a day, and some are watered twice a week. Some lawns face north, some faces south...some are in shade and some are in full sun.
